Chapter 7 Bankruptcy anticipates liquidation of the debtor's assets to repay creditors; most debts are dischargeable. Common exceptions to chapter 7 discharges are child support, spousal support, most student loans, income taxes less than three years old, fines and penalties from criminal cases and civil judgments arising from drunk driving convictions. To reduce assets that could be liquidated in a chapter 7 bankruptcy, exemptions are used to protect certain assets from being lost in their bankruptcy. Depending on your individual circumstances, exemptions will let you keep your house, car, retirement, household goods, and life insurance with cash value. After your bankruptcy petition is filed, there is one creditors meeting which you must attend. At that creditors hearing, a bankruptcy trustee will review your bankruptcy petition and ask you questions about your petition. Usually 60 days after your creditor's meeting, your debts are discharged. There are two required classes you take relating to your bankruptcy, one class is taken before your petition is filed and the second class is taken after you file. The two classes may be taken online or by phone.
